

## The Neshoba County Fair Association Camper Regulations Revised 2019

Every effort has been made to provide each camper with the necessary things to make your stay here at the Neshoba County Fair enjoyable and relaxing. Please take the time necessary to read the following regulations carefully in order that you have a clear understanding of what is expected and required of you while camping at the Neshoba County Fair.

- All camper fees are to be paid in person or mailed to:  
The Neshoba County Fair Association, 16800 Highway 21 South, Philadelphia, MS 39350. Our office is located upstairs in the Fair Association Building on the southwest corner of Founder's Square. Our office number is (601)656-8480.
- PAYMENT (\$280 FOR 30 AMP AND \$330 FOR 50 AMP) FOR THE NEXT FAIR IS DUE BY APRIL 1 OF EACH YEAR. AFTER APRIL 1, A LATE FEE OF \$50.00 WILL BE CHARGED, IF PAYMENT, WITH LATE FEE, IS NOT MADE BY MAY 1, THE SPACE WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY GIVEN UP AND ASSIGNED TO ANOTHER PARTY BY THE CAMPER COMMITTEE. NOTICE OR REMINDERS OF CAMPER PAYMENT WILL NOT BE SENT, IT IS THE CAMPER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO SEE THAT PAYMENT ARRIVES ON TIME.**
- SUBLEASING WILL BE HANDLED BY THE CAMPER COMMITTEE BY SELECTING FROM OUR TEMPORARY CAMPER LIST. DEFINITION OF SUBLEASING: ANY USE OR OCCUPATION OF A CAMPER SITE OTHER THAN THE ASSIGNED PERSON. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS RULE WILL RESULT IN FORFEITING YOUR SITE.
- THE ORIGINAL LESSEE CANNOT TRANSFER THEIR ASSIGNED CAMPING SPACE TO ANY OTHER PARTY. The Camper Committee, after conferring with the original lessee, may change spaces.
- Depending on location, camper spaces are approximately 16' wide by 40' long. This width should provide enough room for a sitting area by the door of each camper. Many camper sites were developed long before slide-outs were available to campers. **If you are assigned and agree to one of the smaller sites and have a slide, you may not be able to fully extend your awning.** Be a good neighbor by not crowding someone's space.
- Water, sewage and electrical hookups are provided for each camper space. No person other than the Fair Electrician is authorized to do any electrical work in the RV campground. It is the camper's responsibility to keep these connections tight and secure to prevent electrical shock, contamination from sewage holding tanks and lines, and the ground from becoming flooded due to leaking water. CAMPERS ARE REQUIRED TO USE A SEWER LINE "DOUGHNUT" OR SEWER CONNECTOR ELBOW WHEN ATTACHING CAMPER SEWER SYSTEM. A sewer line "doughnut" can be purchased when camper parking permits are picked up.
- Each camper is allotted two car permits for parking in the camper area provided that space is available. Car permits must be firmly attached to the lower front windshield on the driver's side of the automobile. Permits found taped to the windshield or otherwise improperly mounted will be confiscated. Parking permits will not be mailed but must be picked up at the camper permit office located behind the caretaker's home two weekends prior to the fair; and Wednesday & Thursday the week the fair begins. **PERSON WHOSE NAME IS ON SITE MUST PICK UP PERMITS.**
- Your camper site number should be on the camper, visible in case of an emergency.
- No horse trailers allowed in the regular camping area.
- No reserved seating at the grandstand.
- All pets must be on a leash at all times with the pet handler disposing of the animal's waste properly.
- CAMPERS MAY PULL IN BY JULY 1, PRIOR TO EACH FAIR. ELECTRICITY AND WATER WILL BE AVAILABLE BY JULY 4, AND WILL BE TURNED OFF THE SECOND MONDAY AFTER THE FAIR ENDS. CAMPER MUST UNDERSTAND THAT SECURITY WILL NOT BE ON DUTY EXCEPT WEEKENDS AND ONE WEEK PRIOR TO THE FAIR. THE FAIR ASSOCIATION CANNOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR THE WELL-BEING OF YOUR CAMPER.
- Campers along with wooden pallets, ply board, carpet or other man-made materials, must be removed by the second Monday after fair ends each year. **If not, camper owner will be billed a clean-up fee of \$100.**
- PRIMITIVE CAMPING AND THE USE OF SLEEPING TENTS OUTSIDE THE CAMPER IS NOT PERMITTED ON THE FAIRGROUND.
- GO CARTS, MINI-BIKES, GOLF CARTS, BICYCLES AND ATV'S ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS UNLESS THEY ARE USED IN AN OFFICIAL CAPACITY. CAR PERMITS ARE NOT TO BE USED FOR THESE VEHICLES.
- A responsible adult (a person over the age of 21) will be in charge of each camper prior to and during the fair. CAMPER LESSEE WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGES OR DISTURBANCES THAT MAY OCCUR AT THE CAMPER SITE.
- All house and ground rules established by the Fair Association for the cabin owners also generally apply to campers.
- Campers who willfully disregard the Rules and Regulations of the Neshoba County Fair Association will result in the camper being removed from the fairgrounds and the camping space automatically given up.
